Swiss Association backs Vietnames AO victims

Switzerland-Vietnam Friendship Association has called international lawyers to ask the government to take step in over the spraying of Dioxin/Agent Orange (AO) during the Vietnam war.

At an international conference on war, held by the Switzerland Sociological Association in the University of Basel from September 12-14, the Switzerland-Vietnam Friendship Association strongly condemned the negative ramifications caused by the war in Vietnam. The association also introduced a book, written by authors from Germany, Vietnam, Switzerland and the US, about impacts of chemical weapons used during the war. The association said it would continue its co-operation with the Vietnam Union of Friendship Organisations and the Vietnam Association for Victims of Agent Orange/Dioxin, as well as drum up public opinion in Switzerland to back Vietnamese AO victims.
